



## NEVADA JOINT UNION HIGH SCHOOL DISTRICT

### RESOLUTION #1-24/25

### Delegation of Authority

**WHEREAS**, Education Code section 35161 allows the Board of Trustees ("Board") of the Nevada Joint Union High School District ("District") to delegate any power vested in itself to the District's chief executive officer or any other designee by adoption of rule, so long as said power is not expressly made nondelegable by statute; and

**WHEREAS**, Education Code section 35161 requires that the Board identify and describe the limits associated with such a delegation of power; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board desires to delegate the additional authorization, under direction of the District's Superintendent, to process, place projects out for bid, award contracts, issue RFPs and RFQs, and approve change orders for projects for the District in an amount not to exceed two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000.) to the Director of Facilities and Safety of the Nevada County Superintendent of Schools.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the Nevada Joint Union High School District Board of Trustees hereby declares, orders, and resolves as follows:

Section 1. That all of the recitals set forth above are true and correct.

Section 2. In accordance with Education Code section 17604 et seq., the Board by rule delegates all functions necessary for the District to authorize, process, place projects out for bid, award contracts, issue RFPs and RFQs, and approve change orders for projects in an amount not to exceed two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000.) to the Director of Facilities and Safety of the Nevada County Superintendent of Schools under the direction of the District Superintendent.

Section 3. This rule of delegation of authority shall expire on June 30, 2025, unless the Board takes action to either terminate this delegation of authority or extend its expiration date prior to that time.
